FUNDING

The Conference was organised on M.U.R.S. initiative with the financial support of:

- The **European Commission** for 180, 000 euros.
- The **Secretary General of the French Presidency of the European Union** for 72,492 euros.
- The **Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique** contributed up to 105,000 euros (permanent personnel and overheads for the organisation of the Conference).
- The **Conseil économique social et environnemental** hosted the two days Conference, at the Palais d'Iéna.
- The evening reception was held in the premises of the **Musée des arts et métiers**.

ATTENDANCE

350 participants from 33 countries registered (64% came from France, 30% from one of the EU countries, 6% from abroad). 33% were female.

300 people attended the two days Conference in Paris.

88 speakers delivered a presentation either in plenary sessions or in one of the nine thematic workshops.
